Camp Life

Since commencing as caretakers we have introduced:

- **Communal Herb Garden**
Please make use of it whilst cooking here at the camp. Also open to advice on herb growing tips.
- **Camp Library**
Take, borrow and/or leave a book. We welcome donations of books, magazines and DVD's.
- **Drought Relief Fundraiser**
Leave your recyclable cans and bottles near the garbage bins and all proceeds go to drought relief.
- **Campfire Kits**
Starter buckets \$5 (include a bucket of wood, firelighters, matches and paper and you can even keep the bucket) or Bags of wood \$15
- **Firepits Rental**
\$50 deposit refundable on return to caretakers office in the bottom area.
- **Booking office**
Located in the top and bottom areas of the campground.

Future Plans

With the support of Management, our plans include:

- **Additional Toilet Block**
Located adjacent to the oval.
- **Renovated Riverfront Sites**
Our 26 prime waterfront sites will be renovated with firepits on a cement slab, shade cloth mats beside the pad, water and purchased bags of wood delivered to your van as needed. Your site will be yours for the entire time you book.
- **Sensory/Quiet Area**
A relaxing place nestled amongst the trees where you can just sit and take in the beauty of nature.
- **Online bookings**
For our 26 prime waterfront sites ONLY will begin on 1 November, via our website. Minimum booking periods will apply during peak times. Watch our facebook and website page for more details.



Camp Fees

Holidaymakers have not had an increase in camp fees for the past five years. In line with improvements being made at Myall River Camp and increased operating costs, the following rates will apply from 1 December, 2019.

★ Peak Season – per site/vehicle

Includes the NSW School holidays, all public holiday long weekends and the months of January and December.

- ★ Riverfront sites (26) \$50 a night
- ★ Oval area and surrounds \$40 a night
- ★ Sites at entry and bordering entry road \$30 a night (no increase)
- 🚗 Additional Vehicles (peak season only) \$10 per vehicle

☆ Non-Peak Season – per site/vehicle

- ☆ Riverfront sites (26) \$40 a night
- ☆ Oval area and surrounds \$30 a night
- ☆ Sites at entry and bordering entry road \$25 a night (no increase)
