We had 9 long weeks without our loyal campers, with pretty much only each other and the wildlife for company. The time gave us the chance to fully appreciate this special place. From stunning sunsets to the eerie calm of dawn; what a treat.

Now we can share it with you again! But (and there is always a but) we need your help to keep our camp a safe place where we can all experience the Aussie bush.

When the Premier announced regional travel was possible again, she made it clear that travel in a Covid-safe environment would need to be different. So we have been busy!

Covid-Safe Camp Life

To enable us to re-open we implemented a Covid-19 Plan.

We marked out our non-riverfront sites in the oval and upper campground area that are 10 metres wide to facilitate social distancing.

Next, a complimentary booking system was set up for all sites. This means travellers can now book ahead.

- **Camp Entry:**

All campers must complete a registration form before entering the park, including a COVID-19 declaration. This form is sent out via email 24 hours before your stay and can be filled in electronically.

- **Booking Conditions:**

We also have flexible booking conditions where guests will be given the option to rebook or receive a refund if Government directives regarding campgrounds change.

- **Visitors:**

Day visitors are only allowed entry if they are visiting campers in the park. Each of these visitors must sign a COVID-19 declaration before entry.

- **Toilets:**

Queuing on the ramp is not allowed. Please wash and sanitise hands before entering the cubicle and when leaving. Children must be accompanied and supervised at all times. Toilets will be cleaned several times a day with anti-bacterial products, so we ask for your patience during these times.

We request all campers observe NSW Government guidelines, including:

- Social distancing of 1.5 metres.
- Observing the number of people gathering limits.
- As well, campers are encouraged to bring self-contained toilets. Following the COVID-19 precautions, please use hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes for enhanced hygiene.



Please remember:

- **Fires:**
Fires are not permitted on the ground, so please bring own fire pits.
- **Wildlife:**
Please do not feed any wildlife in our campground.
